- Field Fellows will be utility players within the Campaign's field operation, and will be assigned tasks as determined by the needs of the Field and voter contact programs.
- Tasks/role may include leading a specific component of the broader Field effort, including Out of State Volunteer Coordinator, Yard Sign/Apparel Coordinator, Supporter Housing Coordinator, or Field Database Coordinator; or may be additional capacity on the voter contact side of the Field operation.

- Self-starter with a strong work ethic who is willing to work non-traditional hours.
