- Recruit, train, manage, and deploy volunteer teams to turn-out and persuade voters to re-elect U.S. Rep. Elissa Slotkin.
- Organize and execute events including canvasses and phone banks to reach pre-assigned voter contact metrics.
- In conjunction with Campaign Field leadership, develop and reach aggressive voter contact metrics in assigned region of district.
- Regularly attend strategic community events that elevate visibility of Campaign and contribute to volunteer recruitment efforts.
- Other responsibilities as required.

- Extremely organized with ability to track multiple priorities at once.
