- Developing strategies to meticulously track progress to goal and clearly communicating them up and down the organizational hierarchy.
- Acting as a lead Campaign representative in assigned Region with grassroots leaders and key activists.
- Planning and executing principal-level events.
- Other responsibilities as assigned.
